- Must be an Oklahoma Junior Limousin Association member in good standing.
- Must be a high school senior or post-secondary student who has not reached the age of 22 as of January 1 of the year the scholarship is awarded.
- A check will be sent directly to the school you are attending after verification of:
 - Enrollment – Student must be enrolled in 12 credit hours.
 - GPA – Student must maintain at least a 2.0 grade-point average. A copy of your transcript is acceptable. If awarded prior to your first semester of college, the scholarship will be issued during the second semester.
