DEADLINE:

Postmarked or emailed no later than May 15.

TERMS:

Ambassadors will be selected for a term on one year. A Junior Ambassador (9 to 15 years of age) and a Senior Ambassador (16 to 21 years of age) will be selected. Age is based as of January 1 of the current calendar year.

REQUIREMENTS:

Applicants must be an active member of OJLA.

SELECTION:

Interviews will be conducted at the annual OLBA Ron Wayland Memorial Field Day in Stillwater, OK.

A committee will interview applicants and make their selections based on individual accomplishments, not solely Limousin-related activities. Applicants should be prepared to present themselves in a professional manner, just as if they were interviewing for a job.

DUTIES:

Ambassadors should be prepared to represent the Limousin breed at cattle-related events within the state as well as on a national level. Duties may include, but are not limited to presenting awards at shows, working in the ring at shows, record-keeping at shows, and soliciting award sponsors and benefit auction items for OLBA.
